



Philips has added several of the new Pronto (TSU7500, RFX6500, TSU3500) to the list of products prohibited from being sold on the internet. In addition, a specific disclaimer is required to be shown when any Internet Permitted Pronto Remotes are sold online. The pertinent parts of the policy follow:

Philips Internet Permitted Products Sales Policy:

- Philips reserves the right to mandate that a specific message and/or disclaimer be displayed next to specialized products that may require additional support than that provided by a website. Currently the list of products this pertains to is the **TSU3000, TSU7000, TSI6400, and TSU500.**
 - These products require the following disclaimer to be displayed in a clearly visible way: **“This product is sold as is. Note that full enjoyment of this product requires professional programming by a trained Custom Installer or person of similar skill. If you purchase this product you AGREE that you assume the responsibility for programming this device yourself, or to hire someone to do it correctly.”**

Internet Excluded Products Policy

- Internet re-sellers may not sell any “Internet Excluded Products”. Product exclusions may be added to, deleted or modified by Philips in its sole discretion from time-to-time. **As of 10/05/05 “Internet Excluded Products” are the Pronto Models TSU7500, TSU3500 and the RFX6500.**
- Product found on the Internet in violation of the Philips Internet Excluded Products Policy will be traced to its source. Philips holds all distributor and retail partners accountable for where products sold to said partners ultimately end up.
